OVERVIEW

This fully accredited course follows the syllabus and requirements of the Association for Project Management Project Fundamentals Qualification (APM PFQ). It will provide understanding of key project terminology in order for participants to gain confidence in a project environment. It will also provide a solid basis of knowledge to consolidate existing project team members' understanding as well as provide an excellent first perspective to those new to the project environment.

This course will help individuals recognize the key aspects of a project and the importance of their role within it. The objectives will be supported and extended by engaging the delegates with an appropriate nuclear case study, providing the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of the tools and techniques through use and experience. The contents of the course are also structured to follow a typical nuclear project life-cycle, from Concept, through Definition and Implementation, to Handover and Closeout.

TRAINING METHOD

This course is highly interactive and demands the full participation of the delegates to ensure they receive the maximum benefit. The use of the case study contextualizes the learning through the use of participative exercises that increase the retention of the knowledge gained.
